## **Trainee Mentorship & Clinical Supervision:**

Cardiology Floor Teaching and General Medical Floor Teaching with UIC Medical students in their M3 Internal Medicine Core Clerkship, AMITA Health Saint Francis Hospital. 2-3 UIC students rotate along with 1-2 internal medicine residents for one-month teaching rounds on cardiology and general medical patients at AMITA Health Saint Francis Hospital. Rounds are 3 days per week, 1 ½ hours per session for approximately 6 months per year.

Patient presentations take place at the bedside and include reviews of physical findings and bedside interactions with the patient as well as discussion of patient problems and review of the trainees diagnostic and management skills. Students and residents are challenged with regard to the completeness and accuracy of data presented, and are expected to defend their diagnostic and therapeutic plans in a logical manner. Trainees are stimulated to acquire new knowledge, and correlate clinical findings with basic science, pathophysiology of disease, skills used to acquire and record clinical data, diagnostic reasoning, differential diagnosis, up-to-date description of disease entities, how patients are affected by personal and social problems, appropriate use of the laboratory and consultants, individualized therapy, knowledge of drug action, prescription writing, and planning for discharge and follow-up of patients
